Any competitors that do not have an EC Gold competitive sport license may apply at the show for a sport license upgrade and pay a \$15 upgrade fee. This will allow them to compete at a level higher than their license at a single competition.

Passports are required for Gold Level show but not for Bronze level shows.

All Canadian Owners & Riders in Silver and above competitions are required to hold both an EC passport and valid EC horse license to compete. In the event a competitor does not have a passport for their horse a temporary horse registration may be purchased at the show for \$25. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of the EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book.

EC Statement of Principle

Equine Canada or EC, The National Equestrian Federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction.

The EC is committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect, and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment.
- Ensuring that owners, trainers, exhibitors and their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses, as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose.
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation and safety as a matter of standard operation procedure.
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare.
- Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices.
- Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions.
- Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be cruel, abusive or inhumane.

ENTRIES: Entries Close Monday, July 21st, 2008

Riders entering a horse in Phase 1 & Phase 2 must complete separate forms, but only need to pay the additional class fees, an AEF fee of \$5.00 and the EC Drug Fee of \$5.00 on the second form.

SHOW INFORMATION

DOGS: All dogs must be on a leash on the show grounds. Absolutely no dogs in schooling area or show arenas at any time.

EC rules will be enforced unless otherwise stated. All exhibitors must be members of the Alberta Hunter Horse Society, the Alberta Equestrian Federation and Equine Canada.

LATE ENTRIES: Entries received after July 21st will be subject to a late entry fee of \$30.00. New entries made after the start of the show will pay a penalty of \$50.00. There will be no exceptions. Late entries should confirm the availability of stabling before traveling to the show.

CANCELLATION OF ENTRIES, REFUNDS, and CHANGES: Exhibitors canceling entries after closing date shall forfeit their entries, except where a certificate of disability from a qualified veterinarian is presented to the office before the start of classes. A fee of \$25 or 20% of the entry (whichever is greater) will be charged on all cancellations. Substitutions will be permitted for a fee of \$25 per entry. After the start of the show, a horse which has shown in one or more classes is eligible for a refund of 50% of the remaining entry fee providing a Vet Certificate is presented to the office. **STABLING FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.**

CONCESSION: A full concession will be in operation on the show grounds each day.

DRUG FEES: Competitors will be assessed a fee of \$5.00 per horse for drug fees.

JUMP CANADA LEVY: Those competing in the Phase 1 Gold level show will be assessed the Jump Canada Levy of \$10.00

COMBINED CLASSES & DIVISIONS: Any class or division will be combined that do not have at least 4 entries 12 hrs. before the first class is scheduled to run.

STABLING: Absolutely NO STALL CHANGES allowed without the approval of the show office and show manager. Limited Stabling is available at a charge of \$185.00 + GST for the tournament. A limited supply of Bulk shavings will be available at no additional cost. Bagged shavings will also be available at a charge of \$8.00 per bag. Day Stalls are available at a charge of \$75 + GST per stall for the duration of the show times each day. Day stalls are available from ½ hour prior to the start of the day to one hour after the end of the day of showing.

MANAGEMENT: The show management reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes that do not fill to their satisfaction. Classes may be split if entries warrant. All entries must be made in writing and signed by the owner or agent. Entries of junior riders must be signed by the parent or legal guardian. Entry fees must accompany entry form. Any horse listed "Entry" is not acceptable. One number will be assigned to each horse. Correct numbers must be worn and clearly visible at all times when riding on the grounds. No number will be issued unless all fees have been paid. Entries received without payment will be considered a post entry. A service fee of \$30.00 will be charged on all NSF cheques.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: All riders must wear protective headgear with a secured harness while riding anywhere on the show grounds. Juniors must wear a properly fitted, ASTM/SEI or BSI approved helmet. It is understood that juniors not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete at this competition. Suitable attire required for all entrants at all times.

TROPHIES, RIBBONS AND PRIZEMONEY

Champion and Reserve Champion prizes will be awarded in each division. Points will be awarded to 6th place on the following system: 1st 7 point, 2nd 5 points, 3rd 4 points, 4th 3 points, 5th 2 points, 6th 1 point

Ribbons will be awarded to 8th place in all classes.

The course will consist of 10 jumps with a common start/finish line. One ground person (number holder) is assigned to each jump. As each rider enters the ring, the ten number holders will randomly draw a number and return to his or her assigned jump. When the Claxton (whistle) is sounded, the number holders will hold up their numbers. The rider has 30 seconds to learn their course and to get on the opposite side of the start line to their jump #1. When the second Claxton is sounded, the rider is to begin the course. The rider has 60 seconds to jump as many fences as possible. AS the ride jumps each fence, the number is lowered. If they successfully complete all 10 jumps the number holders will raise their number again and the rider continues around the course. When the 60 second Claxton is sounded, the rider must cross the timers (finish line) in order to stop the time. The rider receives 2 points for each jump cleared and 1 point for a knockdown. No penalties for refusals. Upon the second refusal the rider is eliminated.
