Rules and Regulations

The management committee reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules and to correct any errors or make alterations that may be necessary in the prize list. The management committee reserves the right to remove any groom, trainer, owner, manager, or rider from the tournament without compensation. Any acts of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials by the owner, rider, manager, trainer, or groom shall disqualify them from further competition in the tournament and the owner shall forfeit all fees. Inhumane treatment of a horse such as polling will not be tolerated. Violation of this rule will result in immediate disqualification, and forfeiture of the fees. In the case of disqualification, the horse winning the succeeding prize shall receive the prize of the disqualified horse and the other prizes will be adjusted accordingly. Courses will be posted in the hitching ring one half hour prior to the start of each class. An approved hard hat with a properly secured and fastened harness is compulsory for all competitors while riding anywhere on the tournament grounds. Horses shall be allowed to compete not to be judged or "Hors Concours" with permission from the management. Anyone exhibiting dangerous or unsportsmanlike behavior may, at the discretion of the tournament committee, be expelled from the grounds and forfeit fees.

Entry Procedure

1. For each horse entered an open check or credit card number (Visa/MC) **MUST** accompany the completed entry form.
2. Entry forms that are not completely filled out will be charged a \$10 penalty fee.
3. Number will not be issued without a cheque or a credit card number to cover the balance of the entries.
4. Late entry forms received after the closing date will be charged a late fee of \$30.00. Post entries (entered on the first day of the show or later) will be assessed a fee of \$50.00.
5. N.S.F. Cheques will result in an additional \$35 service fee.

7. Online entries can be made at www.horseshowtime.com Please ensure a receipt is received in your email on completion of your entry.

Refunds

Exhibitors canceling their entries before the closing date will be issued a refund in full. Those received after the closing date of entries but prior to the start of the tournament, shall, upon presentation of a valid veterinarian certificate, forfeit their stall and office fees, all other fees will be refunded. Non veterinarian scratches will not be refunded after the closing date.

Management

The tournament management reserves the right to limit entries in any division and to refuse or decline any entry without being liable for compensation or damages. Ties for jumper championships will be decided by a coin toss. Ties for hunter championships will be awarded to the rider receiving the most points in classes over fences.

Memberships

All riders, owners and trainers must be a Bronze level member of Equine Canada or higher. New Equine Canada memberships cannot be sold at the show, only temporary memberships at the cost of \$30. All riders, owners and trainers must also be members of the CEDL/AHHS to compete at this competition. New CEDL/AHHS memberships can be purchased at the tournament office.

Passports

Passports are not required for Bronze level EC sanctioned competitions.

Drug Fees

A \$3.50 Drug Fee will be collected for every horse entered in an Equine Canada Bronze tournament.

CEDL/AHHS Levy

All competitors, owners and trainers will be required to be a member of the Canadian Equestrian Development League/Alberta Hunter Horse Society. Memberships can be purchased at the tournament office. This levy helps to fund Horse and Rider Development programs that will directly benefit Alberta athletes.

Schooling & Warm up Rules

All EC sanctioned competitions must use current FEI schooling rules as listed. Refer to Chapter 9, FEI Rules, Article 244 Exercise AND SCHOOLING AREAS AND PRACTISE OBSTACLES. These rules pertain to all hunter, equitation and jumper classes and divisions at all EC sanctioned competitions. Rapping is forbidden, Article A516 and FEI Article 243.

Stabling

Stabling will be available Thursday morning to Sunday. Absolutely NO STALL CHANGES allowed without the approval of the show office and show manager. Permanent Stalls are available for a charge of \$200.00. Temporary Stalls are available for a charge of \$150.00. Day Stalls are available at a charge of \$75 per stall for the duration of the show times each day. Day stalls do not include overnight. Overnight stabling may be available for a fee of \$35 per night but only if the day stall is rented the next day.

Feed & Bedding

5 bags of shavings will be provided for each horse stall, pre bedding will be sold at \$6.00/bag. Any additional shavings required during the competition can be purchased at the tournament office at a cost of \$8.00/bag. Hay is available at \$15/bale.

Dogs

All dogs must be on a leash on the show grounds. There are absolutely no dogs in schooling area or show arenas at any time.

Non Rated Hunter Divisions

2'6" Low & Schooling Hunter

Open to all horses, ponies and riders. Horses will not jog.

2'9" Low & Schooling Hunter

Open to all horses, ponies and riders. Horses will not jog.

3'0" Low Hunter

Open to all horses, ponies and riders. Horses will not jog.

3'3" Low Hunter

Open to all horses and riders. Horses will not jog.

Low Pony Hunter

Open to all ponies and riders. Ponies will not jog.
(Heights will be adjusted accordingly to size of pony)

Baby Green Hunter 2'6"

Open to horses or ponies that have not shown over a course of fences at any show or event prior to January 1st of the current year. Fences may be jumped at a trot or canter. Cross entry only into competitions with fences at 2'6 or under.

2'0" Schooling Hunter

Open to all horses, ponies and riders. Horses will not jog.

2'3" Schooling Hunter

Open to all horses, ponies and riders. Horses will not jog.

2'6" Schooling Hunter

Open to all horses, ponies and riders. Horses will not jog.

2'9" Schooling Hunter

Open to all horses, ponies and riders. Horses will not jog.

2'9" Modified Hunter

Open to all horses and riders. Horses will not jog.

Modified Child/Adult 2'9"

Open to all Junior and Amateur Riders. No cross entry to Modified Hunter 3'3 or Jr/Am Hunter 3'6 at same show.

Modified Junior Amateur Hunter 3'3"

Open to all junior and amateur riders.

Modified Hunter 3'3"

Open to all horses and riders.

Developing Riders Tour Competition Specifications

A developing rider is a rider that has not jumped higher than 2'9 at any competition up to and including the 2010 season.
Finals held at the Santa Claus Classic December 3-5,2010

X-Rail Hunter

Open to developing and BRAVE riders only. Horses will not jog. No horse & rider combination cross entry will any competitions over 2'0.

2'0 Developing Hunter

Open to developing and BRAVE riders only. Horses will not jog. No horse & rider combination cross entry will any competitions over 2'3.

Short Stirrup Pony Hunter 2'3

This division is designed for beginner riders on ponies. No oxers. Ponies will not jog. No horse & rider combination cross entry will any competitions over 2'6.

Short/Long Stirrup/Developing/Brave Hunter 2'3

Horses will not jog. No horse & rider combination cross entry will any competitions over 2'6.

Pre Child/Adult Hunter 2'6

Horses will not jog. No horse & rider combination cross entry will any competitions over 2'9.

BRAVE Riders Qualifying Classes

The BRAVE Horse Show Circuit strives to provide a safe and enjoyable atmosphere for entry level riders to learn the competitive aspect of the hunter/jumper sport. BRAVE encourages an introduction to the provincial and national systems of coaching, riding, and horsemanship. BRAVE also promotes the kind and respectful treatment of our most valuable asset - the horse.

A BRAVE rider is a rider that has not jumped higher than 2'9" at any competition up to and including the 2010

8 yrs & under lead line walk/trot Equitation

Riders are not eligible for any other division.

Trot Pole Division

Flat equitation (walk/trot only) & Trot pole equitation
This division is walk/trot only. Open to riders in their first year of showing. Trainers permitted in the ring. Riders in this division may not show higher than X-Rail at the same show

X-Rail Hunter

Open to developing and BRAVE riders only. Horses will not jog. No horse & rider combination cross entry will any competitions over 2'0".

18" Beginner Rider Equitation

Open to riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. No cross entry with classes higher than 2'3".

Short/Long Stirrup/Developing/Brave Hunter 2'3"

Horses will not jog. No horse & rider combination cross entry will any competitions over 2'6".

Pre Child/Adult Hunter 2'6"

Horses will not jog. No horse & rider combination cross entry will any competitions over 2'9".

Schooling Jumper 2'6" & 2'9"

BRAVE riders in 2'6" & 2'9" jumpers will collect points based on their placing. BRAVE riders may not cross enter into jumper classes over 3'0".

MEDAL COMPETITIONS SPECIFICATIONS

Pre Child/Adult Hunter Medal

There is no minimum requirement to fill this class.

Fences to 2'6". Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders who are not competing at the same show in any hunter or equitation class in which the fences exceed 2'9". The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one horse per rider. **An Open Numerical scoring system must be used with each rider's score announced at the completion of their round. No flat phase. Two tests are required within the course phase.**

Option at final to test the top 4 competitors. Riders return in the same tack.

Junior/ Amateur 0.75m Jumper Medal

There is no minimum requirement to fill this class.

Fences to 0.75m. Open to junior/amateur riders. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one horse per rider. No cross entry to other jumper medals over 0.85m.

An Open Numerical scoring system must be used with each rider's score announced at the completion of their round. No flat phase. Two tests are required within the course phase.

Option at final to test the top 4 competitors. Riders return in the same tack.

Junior/ Amateur 0.90m Jumper Medal

There is no minimum requirement to fill this class.

Fences to 0.90m. Open to junior/amateur riders. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one horse per rider. No cross entry to other jumper medals over 1.0m.

An Open Numerical scoring system must be used with each rider's score announced at the completion of their round. No flat phase. Two tests are required within the course phase.

Option at final to test the top 4 competitors. Riders return in the same tack.

CEDL & GREENHAWK ADULT MEDAL

There is no minimum requirement to fill this class.

Fences to 3'0. Open to Adult and Amateur riders. The Same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. **An Open Numerical scoring system must be used in the 1st round with each riders score announced at the completion of their round. Test the top 4 competitors over fences. Riders return in the same tack.**

CEDL & GREENHAWK CHILDREN'S MEDAL

There is no minimum requirement to fill this class.

Fences to 3'0. Open to Junior riders who are not competing at the same show in any hunter or equitation class in which the fences exceed 3'3". The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one horse per rider. No cross entry into Greenhawk Pony Medal at the same show.

An Open Numerical scoring system must be used in the 1st round with each riders score announced at the completion of their round. Test the top 4 competitors over fences. Riders return in the same tack.

CEDL & GREENHAWK PONY MEDAL

There is no minimum requirement to fill this class.

Fences as per EC Heights. Smalls Jump 2'3".....Medium's Jump 2'6" and Larges Jump 2'9"

Open to junior riders on ponies who are not competing at the same show in any hunter or equitation class in which the fences exceed 3'3". The same pony must be used in all phases. Only one pony per rider.

No cross entry into Greenhawk Children's Medal at the same show.

An Open Numerical scoring system must be used in the 1st round with each riders score announced at the completion of their round. Test the top 4 competitors over fences. Riders return in the same tack.

CEDL & GREENHAWK JUNIOR/AMATEUR MEDAL

There is no minimum requirement to fill this class. Fences to 3'3".

Open to junior/amateur riders. No cross-entry at the same show with the Children's or Adult Medal. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one horse per rider.

An Open Numerical scoring system must be used in the 1st round with each riders score announced at the completion of their round. Test the top 4 competitors over fences. Riders return in the same tack.

CEDL & GREENHAWK JUNIOR/AMATEUR 1.00M JUMPER MEDAL

There is no minimum requirement to fill this class. Fences to 3'3".

Open to junior/amateur riders. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one horse per rider.

An Open Numerical scoring system must be used in the 1st round with each riders score announced at the completion of their round.

Test the top 4 competitors over fences. Riders return in the same tack.

EC RATED HUNTER COMPETITION SPECIFICATIONS

Pre Green Hunter

A Pre-Green Hunter is a horse of any age that has in its first two consecutive years of showing over fences in competitions where the fences have not exceeded 2'9" prior to January 1st of the current year. A Second Year Pre Green horse is one that has not competed in any competitions requiring the entry to jump over 3'0" prior to January 1st of the current year. No cross entry with first year green hunter. First and Second year pre green hunters must be shown in two consecutive years. First year horses may not cross enter into any competitions with fences at 3'3", second year horses may not cross enter into competitions with fences at 3'6".

Junior Amateur Hunter 3'6"

Open to all horses ridden by a Junior or Amateur. Fences will be set to 3'6". No Horse & Rider combination may cross enter with Adult Hunter or Children's Hunter competitions at the same competition.

Adult Amateur Hunter 3'0"

Open to all horses ridden by an Adult Amateur. Riders are restricted to riding a maximum of 3 horses in this division. Riders may not cross enter into any hunter competition with fences exceeding 3'3" or jumper competitions where the fences exceed 1.15m, CET Medal or EC Medal competitions.

Children's Hunter 3'0"

Open to all horses ridden by a junior. Ponies may not cross enter into the Children's Hunter division. Riders may not cross enter into any hunter competition with fences exceeding 3'3" or jumper competitions where the fences exceed 1.15m, CET Medal or EC Medal competitions.

Pony Hunter

Open to all ponies ridden by junior riders subject to the following restrictions:
Junior A riders may ride large ponies. Junior B & C riders may ride ponies of all heights.

Large ponies: exceeds 13.2 hands but not exceeding 14.2 hands.

Medium ponies: exceeds 12.2 hands but not exceeding 13.2 hands.

Small ponies: do not exceed 12.2 hands.

Horses will be judged 40% under saddle, 60% over fences, (20% of over fences score will be Conformation to be judged during the jog after the final over fences classes. Standard Figure eight course will be used. Finals will be held at the Rocky Mountain Classic III, finals will be open to all horses that have accumulated points throughout the year. Classes will be held on grass in the main hunter ring.
